LIVING AS STEWARDS



Shepherds and sheep were so much a part of life for Jesus and those from Galilee. Galilee was, after all, largely a rural area and raising sheep and shepherding was an intricate part of their lives. That is why the image of a shepherd with his sheep was so often used during biblical times. It was a connection with which people could identify.

It is equally important for us today to understand this important cultural connection for them. Shepherding was all about feeding the lambs and the sheep (recall that Jesus tells Peter “Feed my sheep.”), bringing them to good pasture lands and water (“The Lord is my shepherd...

He makes me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside quiet waters; he restores my soul.”); going after lost lambs (“Does he not leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it?”); and protects the sheep in the field and the fold (“The watchman opens the gate, and the sheep listen to his voice.”).

Our Gospel reading today comes from St. John 10: 1-10. In St. John 10: 11, the next verse, Christ declares “I am the good shepherd; the good shepherd lays down his life for his sheep.” As Catholics and Christians, we, too, are called to be Good Shepherds to all those with whom we come in contact. It may be from another culture than ours, but we should understand full well the implications of that.

FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Our Lady of Fatima, Anniversaries are important. They mark for us the passage of time. They give us a chance to ponder the past, live in the present, and wonder about the future. Most of us celebrate our birthdays every year, but the ones with a zero after the first number seem to take on more importance. That's a passing of a decade or even a century for some.



This year we are remembering a time when Our Blessed Mother came to us, through three small children, from May 13, 1917 to October 13, 1917 in a small town near Fatima, Portugal. That was a century ago. In 1947, a new parish was established right here in San Clemente. As with many new parishes, even today, finding a place to celebrate Mass was essential. I've been told there were about 1,500 people living here at that time, but they had a golf course. The golf course opened their doors to this new Catholic Church named Our Lady of Fatima. For many years, the faithful came to church at the club house. In 1962 enough funds were raised to build our current church and that small community had grown substantially. Now after 70 years of serving the people in San Clemente, we see that more than 60,000 people live here and we have records for over 3,000 families.

This is reason to celebrate! Next Saturday, on May 13, we have planned a Mass and May Crowning at 8:30am. For those able, we will take a prayerful walk down to the pier and back. At the same time, a special Fatima Rosary will be prayed in the church for those who wish to stay. We will then gather for a barbeque with live entertainment and games. Tickets for the BBQ are \$2 each or \$5 for a family with small children.

Reflexión de la Corresponsabilidad

Pastores y ovejas formaban parte de la vida de Jesús y de Galilea. Galilea era, después de todo, en gran parte una zona rural y criar ovejas y pastoreo era una parte intrincada de sus vidas. Por eso la imagen de un pastor con sus ovejas era tan frecuentemente usada durante los tiempos bíblicos. Era una conexión con la cual la gente podía identificarse.

Es igualmente importante para nosotros hoy entender esta importante conexión cultural para ellos. El pastoreo era todo acerca de la alimentación de los corderos y las ovejas (recuerda que Jesús le dice a Pedro "Apacienta mis ovejas."), Trayendolos a buenos pastos y buena agua ("El Señor es mi pastor ... Él me hace acostarme en pastos verdes; Me conduce junto a las aguas tranquilas, él restaura mi alma."); Ir tras corderos perdidos ("¿No deja los noventa y nueve en campo abierto y va tras la oveja perdida hasta que la encuentra?"); Y protege a las ovejas en el campo y en el redil ("El vigilante abre la puerta, y las ovejas escuchan su voz").

Nuestra lectura del Evangelio hoy viene de San Juan 10:1-10. En San Juan 10: 11, el siguiente versículo, Cristo declara: "Yo soy el buen pastor; El buen pastor da su vida por sus ovejas ". Como católicos y cristianos, también nosotros somos llamados a ser buenos pastores para todos aquellos con quienes tenemos contacto. Puede ser de otra cultura que la nuestra, pero debemos entender bien las implicaciones de eso.

Nos dan la oportunidad de reflexionar sobre el pasado, vivir en el presente, y preguntarnos sobre el futuro. La mayoría de nosotros celebramos nuestros cumpleaños cada año, pero los que tienen un cero después del primer número parecen tomar más importancia. Eso es el paso de una década o incluso un siglo para algunos.

Este año estamos recordando una época en que Nuestra Madre Bendita vino a nosotros, a través de tres niños pequeños, del 13 de mayo de 1917 al 13 de octubre de 1917 en un pequeño pueblo cerca de Fátima, Portugal. Eso fue hace un siglo. En 1947, una nueva parroquia fue establecida aquí mismo en San Clemente. Como con muchas parroquias nuevas, aún hoy en día, encontrar un lugar para celebrar la misa era esencial.
